Dear Theatre Senior Parent,

In anticipation of the Booker T. Washington High School for the Performing and Visual Arts (BTWHSPVA) College Showcase on **November 17-18, 2017**, this letter is a reminder that, pursuant to the exceptions under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), the Dallas Independent School District, including and through BTWHSPVA, may release education records and personally identifiable information of students, without prior written parental consent to officials of other schools or school systems in which the student seeks or intends to enroll for purposes related to the student's enrollment or transfer. Further, disclosure of information is allowed to personnel involved with a student's application for, or receipt of, financial aid. Additional information about the release of student records and personally identifiable information may be found in the Student Handbook, as well as Board Policy FL (Local).

BTWHSPVA anticipates that requests from participating colleges will include requests for information such as transcripts, grade point averages, standardized test scores and financial information to assist in the assessment of financial aid qualification.
